Applicants may support the application with other documents (publications, professional, cultural and academic titles) and with a certificate of qualifications in English language. According to art.1 of the Decree of the President of the Italian Republic 20 October 1998, No. 403, applicants are allowed, on their own penal responsibility, to present personal certifications instead of the original documents.
